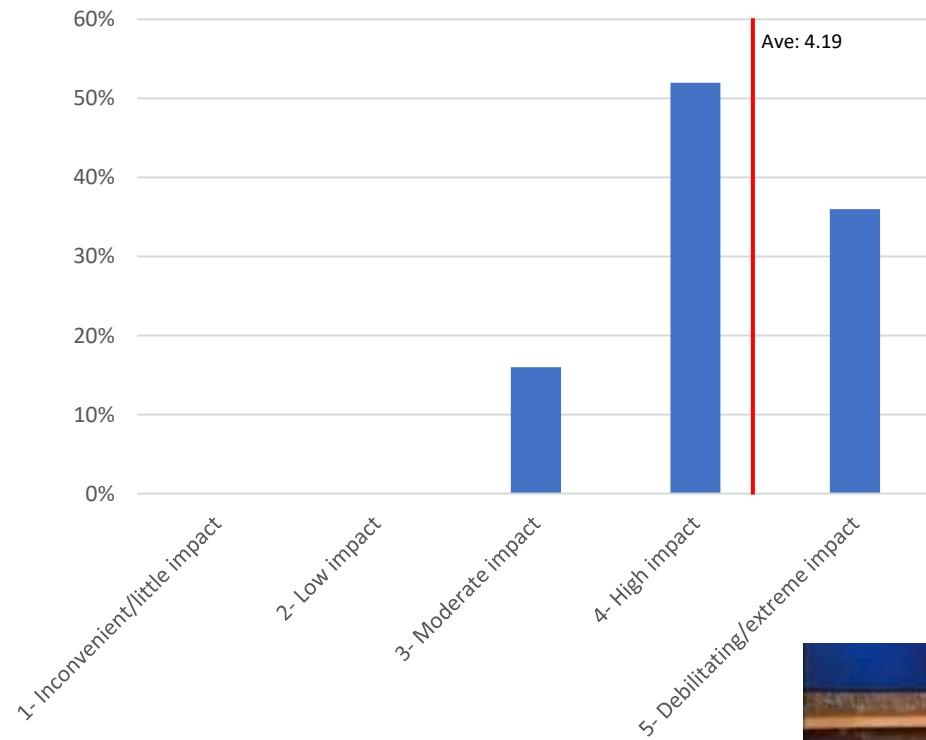

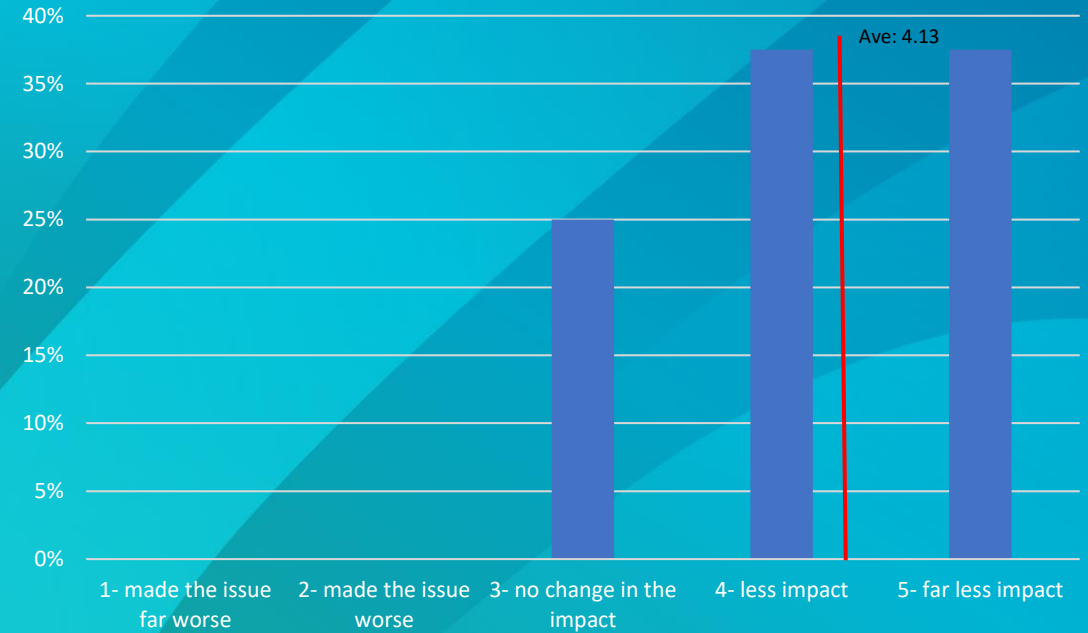
Current impact of flying-fox roost



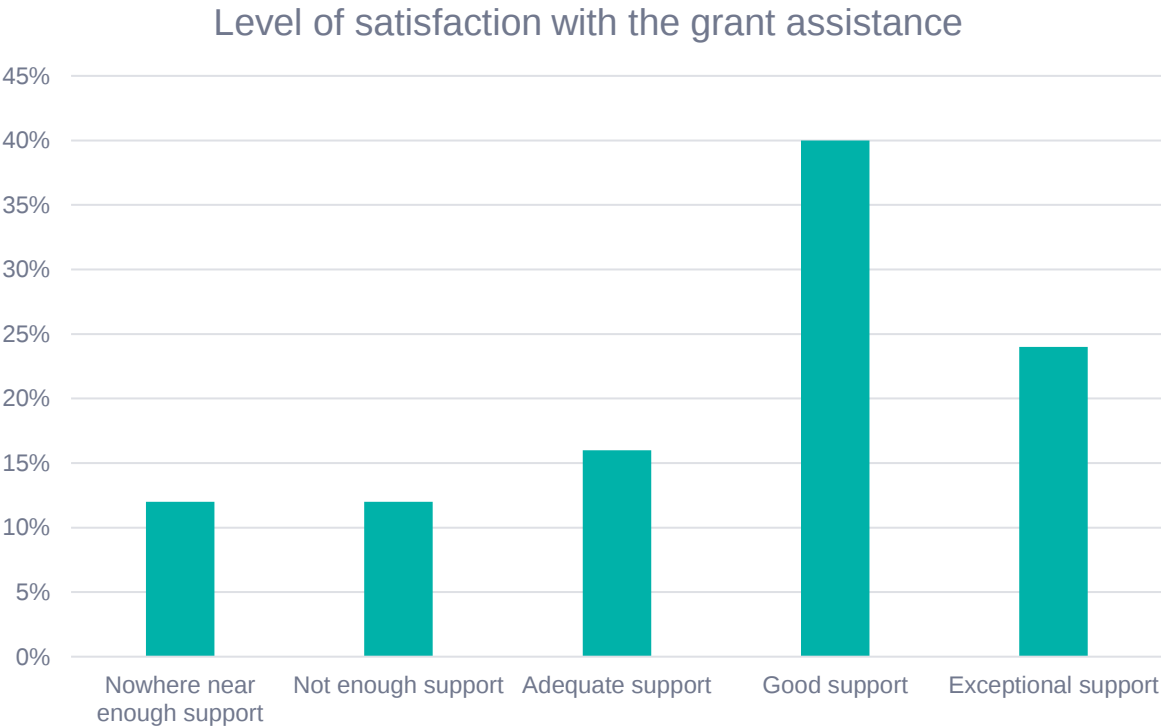

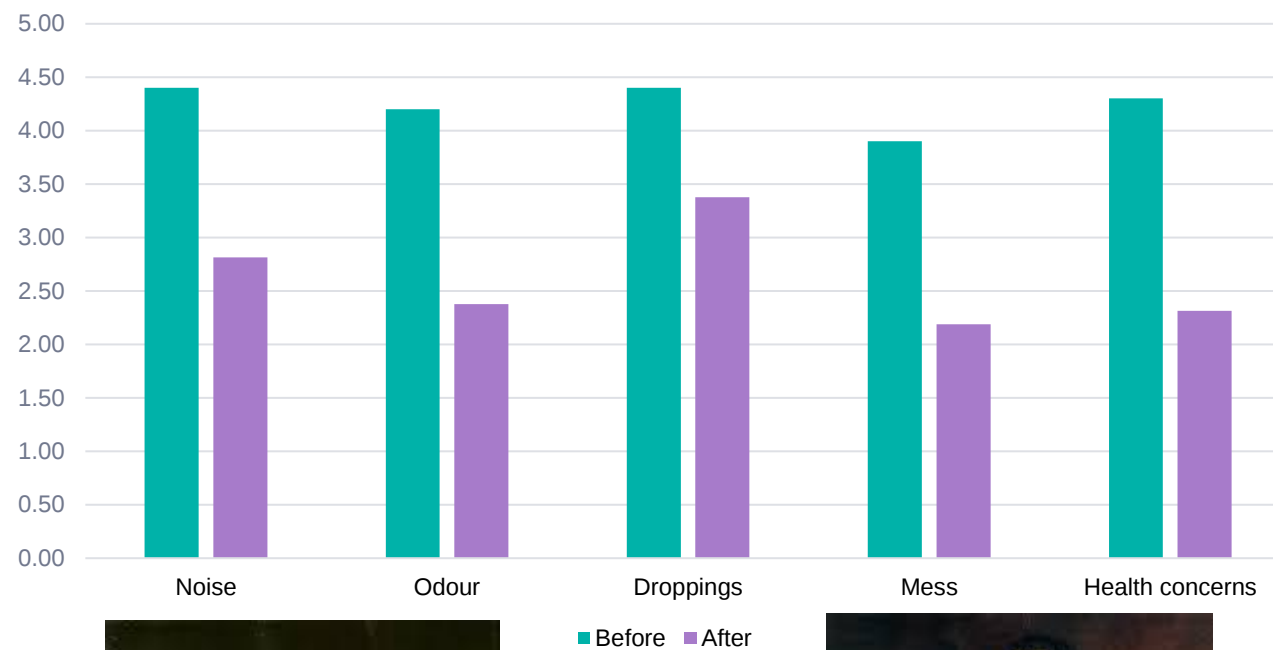

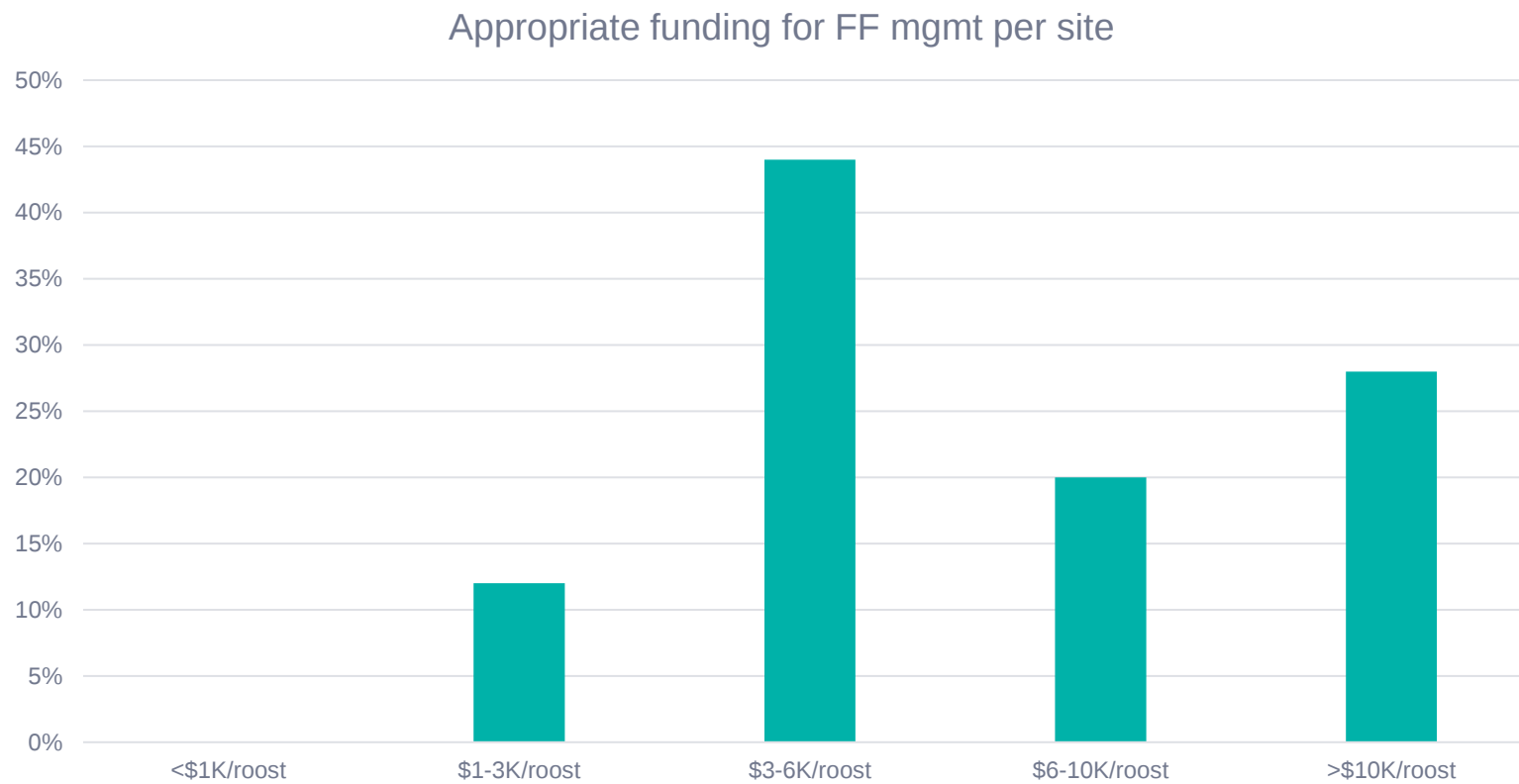

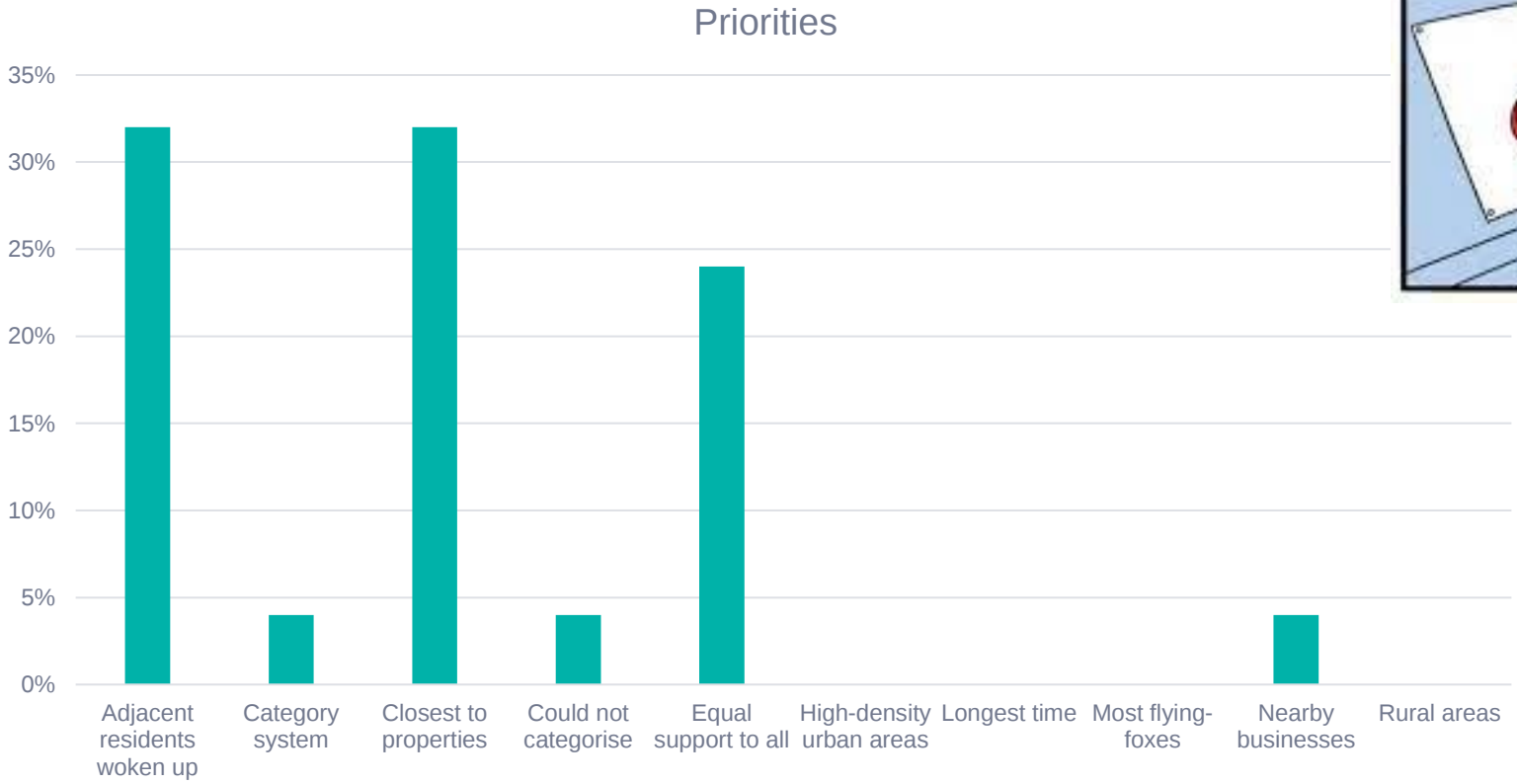
- There are 16 high conflict sites, with 250 impacted properties
